

#### **Sophie Book Update**



Thanks to a faithful supporter, Missionary Sophie Muller's book, is now being readied for reprinting. It truly is a book of miracles. One young "White woman" surviving the jungle to reach thousands for Christ. Side Note: Just recently we made a connection with

some who followed in the footsteps of Sophie and continued the witness in the jungles. Those that have read *The Voice in the Wilderness*, know that we were given stewardship of four Bible translations that Sophie completed. In her book, that we are currently reprinting, Sophie mentions the missionaries who lived on the border of the jungle and used their mimeograph to produce copies of her translations for the Indians. Their son later also became a lifetime jungle missionary, surviving a FARC kidnapping. Sadly, he and his wife died one day apart from each other in 2021, but praise the Lord, the witness in the jungle still continues today as we have seen first-hand on our recent

Mission to Colombia.
