# PRAYER LETTER

# **Update**

The tick of the typing keys ring out loud and clear in the ministry office as we prepare this news-letter to you. Printing has, for over 70 years, been a significant part of mission efforts. In a 1979 personal message to readers, Bro. Royce, founder of The Voice in the Wilderness, wrote-

At present, our greatest expense is the printing and postage that is necessary for the newsletter and other printed materials which we feel are vital to our readers. If we can increase our income for next year by as much as even \$300 a month, we can accomplish our goal...The amount we give will depend entirely on your gifts to this work for we have no other means of support.

Continuing in the same spirit of our founding, The Voice in the Wilderness pours much time, effort, and money into the printed word, many times referring to our resources as a "Printed Missionary." As we print and distribute, whether that be John/Romans Scriptures, The Constitution Defender, missionary biographies, sermons or lessons, that word penetrates the heart of the readers and makes a lasting difference that reaches worldwide for eternity's sake. Even with the influx of online and digital material, printing is still strong and vital. In 2021, U.S. publishers sold over 800 million books, with Amazon printing at least 40% of those. Printing is NOT trending down but remains in high demand. Right now, just the financial printing need of The Voice in the Wilderness for the remainder of 2023 exceeds \$10,000. Being a "Printed Missionary" is a worth-while investment and certainly not archaic. Thank you, friends, for partnering with us in this commitment. Just in the last month, several gave and helped us replace our Rapid Fire Stapler for office productions, continue distribution of the Cherokee Book of John, and ship printed materials to Venezuela, where we cannot personally go. (Other details are given throughout this newsletter). While printing in the U.S. is undoubtedly strong, what is being printed is notable and concerning. Educational textbook printing is on the decrease while romance novels have flooded the market and fantasy has invaded and overtaken the children's book industry. Even the "Christian" book field has been overwhelmed with self-help content and anti-fundamental trends. Truth in print is needed more than ever. In our travels, people are looking for truth, but many times are being swept away by the fake, the make-believe, or lies purported as truth. Why are The Constitution Defender, Truth or Myth, Scripture booklets and other publications in constant back-order status? - because they uniquely present the truth in printed format and that is in high demand. Our next

printing project is a special newsletter highlighting 70 years of ministry.

Through this will come, Lord willing, significant gifts, large

and small, that will propel further missions printing, preaching, reaching, and teaching.
