Many ministry miles traveled with little people in the back seat can only mean one thing - YOU better have a playlist full of good Bible stories and songs to carry you through! Yet in this modern, techie-age, gone are the Walkman, cassette tapes and even the CD players have vanished as we rely on the airwaves to connect around every corner. Well - GIANT FAIL for those internet signals - they just can't compete with God's beautiful mountain valleys and peaks. The "Dead Zone" struck us as we traveled to a church for ministry, and one (who will remain unnamed), upon hearing why her favorite story had suddenly paused, said in an eerie and concerned little voice: "Daddy, if this is the 'dead zone,' who died here?" That brought about a chuckle within the car and a long scientific explanation that probably wasn't entirely understood. The "Dead Zone" can feel like a lonely and sometimes scary place, but God is still there. For any of us, it might be a time of indecision, sickness, financial challenges, relationship stress, mismanagement, discontentment, spiritual complacency, or a host of other situations that come in the miles we must all travel...but God is still there. In 70 years of incredible ministry, The Voice in the Wilderness has witnessed God's sustaining hand as souls were influenced for eternity, thousands of pounds of Scriptures received and distributed, and preaching, teaching and reaching continued worldwide. Each day of ministry brings new opportunities and challenges, but God is still there. Historically, August has been "Anniversary" month for The Voice in the Wilderness. Back in the early days, Bro. Royce (founder) would scrawl out a note of encouragement to his readers and some blessed soul would decipher, convert to type, and print "My Personal Message." In the August 1979 letter, he was rejoicing in 42 years of preaching and reminiscing about his first tent revival in Oklahoma where he preached for three weeks and was given an offering of 86 cents! He goes on to describe the nearly 150 missions points he had visited and upcoming trips anticipated. Concluding his letter, he says,

If the Lord speaks to you to do something special toward helping the work this month, we will be much obliged. My sincere thanks to all of you for all you have done and a very special thanks to those of you who for many years have been constant supporters either by prayer, offerings or both. I shall be eternally grateful...We look daily for your letters, they are the lifeline of the work.

And in true, "Bro. Royce style" he included a good little poem and pages of worthy content for the reader. Whether it was 1979 or many miles down that road to 2023, God is still there, and YOU, your prayers, and letters remain the lifeline of this work. Thank you for reading, praying, and supporting.
