Rebekah, AbiNoelle, and AmiJoy enthusiastically shared TRUTH and taught practical techniques for being a biblical defender in today's world. Following the session, we spent three days, speaking with homeschool families and sharing resources from The Voice in the Wilderness. A neurologist, who has continued working amidst COVID challenges all while homeschooling her three children, shared that her heart had been stirred in the session, and she had been challenged to incorporate more Bible memorization and historical document memorization into their homeschool routine. Another family expressed that they too had been inspired to pursue more intense study and memorization of TRUTH.
