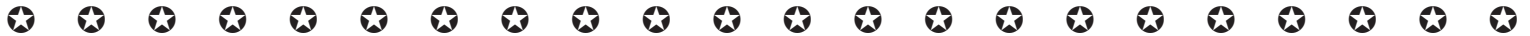

When the founder's came out of Independence Hall in Philadelphia having completed the Constitution, a lady asked Franklin, "Well, Sir, what have you given us, a republic or a democracy?" Color all the stars above that have numbers that appear three times within the letters of "We the People." Match the remaining numbers with the alphabet chart. Write those letters in the blanks above to discover Franklin's answer.



Supplies: heavy paper (card stock). scissors, crayons, or markers, star pattern

Instructions:

1. Draw two identical stars on the heavy paper.
2. Decorate the two stars on both sides, then cut them out.
3. Make one slit in each star. On one star, the slit goes from an inner corner to the center point of the star; on the other star, the slit goes from an outer corner to the center point.
4. Slip the two stars together through the slits you just cut. For stability, you may have to tape the stars where they meet at slits.
