Please call, email, and write your congressman, especially House Speaker John Boehner and encourage them to vote for HCR 38 in celebration of the 400th Anniversary of the King James Bible. President Taft and King George honored God's Word on the 300th Anniversary of the King James Bible. This Congress must do the same! Could it be if Speaker Boehner would pass HCR 38 God would undertake efforts to stop this liberal insanity in America? Campus Crusade for Christ has changed their original name to "CRU" to avoid any images of violence and intolerance. Never should a preacher mention homosexuality in a Biblical context as being sin. That would certainly be hate mongering and intolerant. Sadly, conservative and fundamental churches are giving in to this pressure of compromise.
